Important High Point Award Program Change

The National Walking Horse Association is dedicated to providing its membership with the best possible High Point Award Program possible. Many members have expressed their thoughts and suggestions regarding how to improve the current program. Having reviewed the many comments, the Board of Directors has decided to implement a new procedure that will allow the program to be self-supporting. This year, in addition to the traditional ribbons, the Champions and Reserve Champions will automatically receive keeper trophies to commemorate their victories. However, in order for your horse to be eligible for NWhA's High Point Program, you must nominate your horse annually. A nomination form and fee of \$10 per horse is required by the deadline of June 1st in order for your horse to participate in the 2010 program. Points will count retroactively from the beginning of the 2010 show season but all applications and fees must be postmarked &/or received in the NWhA office on or before June 1, 2010. The \$10 nomination fee is per horse (not per division). This fee allows your horse to compete for points in any class for which it is shown.
